We will be meeting quarterly with All Star Gaming moving forward.

Swimming: Season has started, club swimmers have not transitioned over yet. Have had 4 meets so far, bigger meets begin in January.

Wrestling: This past weekend in Xenia finished 2nd out of 20 teams with one wrestler placing 1st. JV was here and finished 3rd out of 17 teams with 2 wrestlers placing 1st. Held a youth tourney with over 525 kids participating. Dual with Frankin on Wednesday, tourney next weekend.

Boys Bowling: Both Varsity and JV Boys are 1-0 in GMC and 1-1 overall, team has 13 (8 Jr, 4 So, 1 F) Varsity consists of 3 Jr and 3 So. Boys have had two matches against Mason and Sycamore. They lost to Mason but the team scored their highest points as a team, 134 more points then last year. Against Sycamore, they won, the first win in two years. They will be competitive this year. Have some great Spiritwear in the works for both Girls and Boys teams. Girls Varsity beat Mason, top bowler is a Freshman with a 146 average. Varsity girls also beat Sycamore. They sit 2-0 overall and 1-0 in GMC. JV, have 4 girls and sit 1-1 overall and 1-0 in GMC. This week they face Mason again and West.
